

## Moorabool's A-Z Recycling & Waste Guide

- Use this guide to help you make the best decision when clearing out common items from the kitchen, garage and everywhere else in your home.
- Many items can be recycled into new products, saving valuable resources, energy and landfill space.
- A cost may be associated with some disposal or recycling services – contact the provider first to check.

<b>Absorptive pads (e.g. in meat trays)</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Dispose in your garbage bin (red lid) or take to a <a href="#">Moorabool Shire Transfer Station</a> (fees apply)</li> </ul>
<b>Aerosol cans (empty)</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Recycle in your recycling bin (yellow lid) or take to a <a href="#">Moorabool Shire Transfer Station</a></li> </ul>
<b>Aluminium foil</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Recycle in your recycling bin (yellow lid) or take to a <a href="#">Moorabool Shire Transfer Station</a> (no cost)</li> <li>• Roll into a ball about the size of a tennis ball before recycling. Ensure no food remnants are on the foil.</li> <li>• When possible, use foil multiple times</li> <li>• Avoid waste by using a non-stick baking dish and lid</li> </ul>
<b>Appliances</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Reuse by selling, swapping, or giving away. Try eBay, Gumtree or local Buy Swap Sell pages.</li> <li>• Contact your local Op Shop – find out if they accept working electronic items</li> <li>• Recycle as e-waste at a <a href="#">Moorabool Shire Transfer Station</a> (no cost)</li> <li>• Never put any electronic item in a household bin, e-waste is banned from landfill and is a contaminant in the recycling bin.</li> </ul>
<b>Apple brand products</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Can be traded in – visit the <a href="#">Apple trade-in</a> website</li> <li>• Recycle as e-waste at a <a href="#">Moorabool Shire Transfer Station</a> (no cost)</li> <li>• Never put any electronic item in a household bin, e-waste is banned from landfill and is a contaminant in the recycling bin.</li> </ul>
<b>Asbestos</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Visit the <a href="#">Asbestos Victoria website</a></li> <li>• Contact <a href="#">Worksafe</a></li> </ul>
<b>Ash (fireplace ash from wood only; must be cold)</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Allow to cool and recycle via your home compost bin</li> <li>• Allow to cool, put in a bag and dispose in your garbage bin (red lid) or take to a <a href="#">Moorabool Shire Transfer Station</a> (fees apply)</li> </ul>

<b>Avocado pit</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Dispose in your garbage bin (red lid) or take to a <a href="#">Moorabool Shire Transfer Station</a> (fees apply)</li> <li>• Recycle in your home compost bin or worm farm.</li> </ul>
<b>Baby wipes</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Dispose in your garbage bin (red lid) or take to a <a href="#">Moorabool Shire Transfer Station</a> (fees apply)</li> <li>• Never flush wipes of any kind down the toilet – they cause major sewer blockages.</li> <li>• Avoid waste by using reusable cloth wipes that can be laundered</li> </ul>
<b>Baking paper</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Dispose in your garbage bin (red lid) or take to a <a href="#">Moorabool Shire Transfer Station</a> (fees apply)</li> <li>• Avoid waste by using non-stick pans instead</li> </ul>
<b>Balloons</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Dispose in your garbage bin (red lid) or take to a <a href="#">Moorabool Shire Transfer Station</a> (fees apply)</li> <li>• Releasing balloons into the environment is littering and illegal in Victoria</li> </ul>
<b>Band-aids</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Dispose in your garbage bin (red lid) or take to a <a href="#">Moorabool Shire Transfer Station</a> (fees apply)</li> </ul>
<b>Barbecues (mostly metal)</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Reuse by selling, swapping, or giving away. Try eBay, Gumtree or local Buy Swap Sell pages.</li> <li>• Recycle at a <a href="#">Moorabool Shire Transfer Station</a> (fees may apply)</li> <li>• Gas bottles not accepted at Transfer Stations – see <a href="#">Elgas SWAP'n'GO</a></li> </ul>
<b>Batteries (Household, NBN and car batteries)</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Recycle household batteries at the sorting station at:             <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Lerderderg Library in Main Street, Bacchus Marsh</li> <li>○ Ballan Council Office, 15 Stead Street Ballan</li> <li>○ Darley Council Office, 182 Halletts Way Darley</li> </ul> </li> <li>• Recycle household batteries at <a href="#">Aldi or Battery World battery recycling sites</a></li> <li>• Recycle household, NBN &amp; car batteries at a <a href="#">Moorabool Shire Transfer Station</a></li> <li>• Avoid waste by using rechargeable batteries where possible</li> <li>• Never put batteries in a household bin – they are banned from landfill and can cause fires in garbage trucks</li> </ul>

<p><b>Beauty Products</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Send to the <a href="#">BRAD</a> - Banish Recycling And Disposal Program</li> </ul> <p>The Program accepts:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Toothpaste tubes, floss containers and old plastic toothbrushes via Colgate's Oral Care Recycling Program</li> <li>○ Electric toothbrush heads</li> <li>○ Medical ointment tubes</li> <li>○ Hair gel tubes and caps</li> <li>○ Hair paste plastic jars and caps</li> <li>○ Lip balm tubes</li> <li>○ Face soap dispensers and tubes</li> <li>○ Lotion bottles, tubes, dispensers, and jars</li> <li>○ Shaving foam tubes (no cans)</li> <li>○ Plastic razors and blades via the Gillette Recycling Program</li> <li>○ Lip gloss tubes</li> <li>○ Mascara tubes</li> <li>○ Eye liner pencils and cases</li> <li>○ Eye shadow tubes</li> <li>○ Concealer tubes and sticks</li> <li>○ Medical blister packs</li> </ul> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Or dispose in your garbage bin (red lid) or take to a Moorabool Shire Transfer Station (fees apply)</li> </ul>
<p><b>Bed base &amp; Bed head</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Contact <a href="#">Bacchus Marsh Rotary: Western Emergency Relief Network (WERN)</a> to confirm if this item is accepted for donation</li> <li>• Reuse by selling, swapping, or giving away. Try eBay, Gumtree or local Buy Swap Sell pages.</li> <li>• Dispose of at a <a href="#">Moorabool Shire Transfer Station</a> (fees apply)</li> </ul>
<p><b>Bedding</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Reuse by selling or donating to your local op-shop/charity</li> <li>• Contact your local vet or animal shelter – find out if bedding is accepted</li> <li>• Recycle by sending to <a href="#">Upparel</a></li> <li>• Recycle by donating to <a href="#">Southern Cross Recycling</a></li> <li>• Dispose in your garbage bin (red lid) or take to a Moorabool Shire Transfer Station (fees apply)</li> </ul>
<p><b>Berry punnets</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• If numbered 1, 2 or 5 - recycle in your recycling bin (yellow lid) or take to a <a href="#">Moorabool Shire Transfer Station</a></li> <li>• Reuse as a pot to raise seedlings</li> <li>• If numbered 3,4,6,7 dispose in your garbage bin (red lid) or take to a <a href="#">Moorabool Shire Transfer Station</a> (fees apply)</li> </ul>
<p><b>Binders/folders (plastic with metal rings)</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Reuse/recycle via <a href="#">GreenCollect</a></li> <li>• Dispose in your garbage bin (red lid) or take to a <a href="#">Moorabool Shire Transfer Station</a> (fees apply)</li> </ul>

<p><b>Biscuit trays (plastic tray inside packet of biscuits)</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• If numbered 1, 2 or 5 - recycle in your recycling bin (yellow lid) or take to a <a href="#">Moorabool Shire Transfer Station</a></li> <li>• If numbered 3,4,6,7 dispose in your garbage bin (red lid) or take to a <a href="#">Moorabool Shire Transfer Station</a> (fees apply)</li> </ul>
<p><b>Blankets (electric)</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Contact your local animal shelter or vet – find out if they will accept electric blankets</li> <li>• Contact your local Op Shop – find out if they accept working electronic items</li> <li>• Cut off the electrical cables and recycle the cables at a <a href="#">Moorabool Shire Transfer Station</a></li> <li>• Never put any electronic item in a household bin, e-waste is banned from landfill and is a contaminant in the recycling bin.</li> </ul>
<p><b>Blister packs (for medicine/pills)</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Dispose in your garbage bin (red lid) or take to a <a href="#">Moorabool Shire Transfer Station</a> (fees apply)</li> <li>• Send to the <a href="#">BRAD</a> - Banish Recycling and Disposal Program</li> </ul>
<p><b>Bones (raw, from meat and seafood)</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Recycle in your Bokashi bin or green cone solar composter</li> <li>• Dispose in your garbage bin (red lid) or take to a <a href="#">Moorabool Shire Transfer Station</a> (fees apply)</li> </ul>
<p><b>Bones (cooked, from meat and seafood)</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Recycle in your Bokashi bin or green cone solar composter</li> <li>• Dispose in your garbage bin (red lid) or take to a <a href="#">Moorabool Shire Transfer Station</a> (fees apply)</li> </ul>
<p><b>Books</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Avoid waste by borrowing books from one of <a href="#">Moorabool's Libraries</a></li> <li>• Reuse by swapping, giving away or donating to your local charity/op-shop</li> <li>• Recycle in your recycling bin (yellow lid) or take to a <a href="#">Moorabool Shire Transfer Station (no cost)</a>. Remove plastic or laminated covers first</li> </ul>
<p><b>Bottle tops/lids (steel or plastic)</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Steel tops can be recycled by collecting them in a steel can (e.g. baked beans tin), squashing closed when full and placing in your recycling bin (yellow lid)</li> <li>• Plastic tops to be removed from bottles and disposed of in your garbage bin (red lid)</li> </ul>
<p><b>Bottles (plastic)</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• If numbered 1, 2 or 5 - recycle in your recycling bin (yellow lid) or take to a Moorabool Shire Transfer Station. Remove bottle lids and place in garbage bin (red lid)</li> <li>• If numbered 3,4,6,7 dispose in your garbage bin (red lid) or take to a Moorabool Shire Transfer Station (fees apply)</li> </ul>
<p><b>Bottles (glass)</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Recycle in your recycling bin (yellow lid) or take to a Moorabool Shire Transfer Station</li> <li>• Remove steel lids, collect in a steel can, squash closed when full, then recycle</li> </ul>

<p><b>Boxes (cardboard)</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Recycle in your recycling bin (yellow lid) or take to a <a href="#">Moorabool Shire Transfer Station</a></li> <li>• Large boxes are best taken to a <a href="#">Moorabool Shire Transfer Station</a> – don't squash them into a bin as they get stuck.</li> <li>• Reuse by offering to someone who might be moving to a new house</li> </ul>
<p><b>Branches (large, over 10cm in diameter and 55cm long)</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Use for firewood or garden projects</li> <li>• Recycle at a <a href="#">Moorabool Transfer Station</a> (fees apply)</li> </ul>
<p><b>Branches (small, up to 10cm in diameter and 55cm long)</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Recycle in your optional green waste bin (urban areas) (lime green lid)</li> <li>• Cut up smaller / mulch and place in your compost bin</li> <li>• Recycle at a <a href="#">Moorabool Transfer Station</a> (fees apply)</li> </ul>
<p><b>Bread bags (plastic)</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Reuse for waste bags or as a dog poo bag</li> <li>• Recycle at Coles Bacchus Marsh via the <a href="#">REDcycle soft plastics recycling program</a></li> <li>• Dispose in your garbage bin (red lid) or take to a <a href="#">Moorabool Shire Transfer Station</a> (fees apply)</li> </ul>
<p><b>Bread tags</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Donate to <a href="#">Aussie Bread Tags for Wheelchairs</a></li> <li>• Dispose in your garbage bin (red lid) or take to a <a href="#">Moorabool Shire Transfer Station</a> (fees apply)</li> </ul>
<p><b>Bubble wrap</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Reuse to wrap fragile objects or presents</li> <li>• Recycle at Coles Bacchus Marsh via the <a href="#">REDcycle soft plastics recycling program</a></li> <li>• Dispose in your garbage bin (red lid) or take to a <a href="#">Moorabool Shire Transfer Station</a> (fees apply)</li> </ul>
<p><b>Bricks, rubble, rocks, concrete and building materials</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Reuse by selling, swapping, or giving away. Try eBay, Gumtree or local Buy Swap Sell pages.</li> <li>• Dispose by hiring a skip.</li> <li>• Visit <a href="#">Detox Your Home</a> for disposal of toxic materials</li> <li>• See <a href="#">Sustainability Victoria</a> for more information</li> <li>• These materials are not accepted in any Council bin or at any Transfer Station. This includes contaminated soil and asbestos.</li> </ul>
<p><b>Brochures/Glossy paper</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Recycle in your recycling bin (yellow lid) or take to a <a href="#">Moorabool Shire Transfer Station</a></li> </ul>
<p><b>Cameras</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Reuse by selling, swapping, or giving away. Try eBay, Gumtree or local Buy Swap Sell pages.</li> <li>• Contact your local Op Shop – find out if they accept working electronic items</li> <li>• Recycle as e-waste at a <a href="#">Moorabool Shire Transfer Station</a> (no cost)</li> </ul>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Never put any electronic item in a household bin, e-waste is banned from landfill and is a contaminant in the recycling bin.</li> </ul>
<b>Cans (steel or aluminium)</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Recycle in your recycling bin (yellow lid) or take to a <a href="#">Moorabool Shire Transfer Station</a></li> <li>• Reuse steel cans as plant pots or containers for storage, e.g. nails/screws etc.</li> </ul>
<b>Car batteries</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Recycle at a <a href="#">Moorabool Shire Transfer Station</a></li> <li>• Never put batteries in any bin – they can cause fires in the collection trucks</li> </ul>
<b>Car/auto parts and tyres</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Reuse by selling online or by giving away</li> <li>• Recycle metal and tyres at a <a href="#">Moorabool Shire Transfer Station</a> (fees apply)</li> <li>• Contact a local scrap dealer to recycle a car body</li> </ul>
<b>Cardboard (unwaxed)</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Recycle in your recycling bin (yellow lid) or take to a <a href="#">Moorabool Shire Transfer Station</a></li> <li>• Large boxes are best taken to a <a href="#">Moorabool Shire Transfer Station</a> – don't squash them into a bin as they get stuck.</li> <li>• Reuse by offering to someone who might be moving to a new house</li> </ul>
<b>Cardboard (waxed - e.g. fruit boxes)</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Dispose in your garbage bin (red lid)</li> <li>• Reuse by offering to someone who might be moving to a new house</li> <li>• Avoid waxed cardboard if possible</li> </ul>
<b>Carpet/carpet underlay</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Dispose of at a <a href="#">Moorabool Shire Transfer Station</a> (fees apply)</li> </ul>
<b>Cartridges (printer/toner)</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Recycle household batteries at the sorting station at: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Lerderderg Library in Main Street, Bacchus Marsh</li> <li>○ Ballan Council Office, 15 Stead Street Ballan</li> <li>○ Darley Council Office, 182 Halletts Way Darley</li> </ul> </li> <li>• Recycle as e-waste at a <a href="#">Moorabool Shire Transfer Station</a> (no cost)</li> <li>• Recycle through <a href="#">Planet Ark</a></li> <li>• Never put any electronic item in a household bin, e-waste is banned from landfill and is a contaminant in the recycling bin.</li> </ul>
<b>Cassette cover and casing (tape removed)</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Dispose in your garbage bin (red lid) or take to a <a href="#">Moorabool Shire Transfer Station</a> (fees apply)</li> </ul>
<b>Cassette tapes</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Recycle at <a href="#">Green Collect (Braybrook)</a></li> <li>• Reuse by donating to your local charity/op-shop</li> <li>• Dispose in your garbage bin (red lid) or take to a <a href="#">Moorabool Shire Transfer Station</a> (fees apply)</li> </ul>

<b>Cat Litter</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Dispose in your garbage bin (red lid) or take to a <a href="#">Moorabool Shire Transfer Station</a> (fees apply)</li> <li>• Wrap in old newspaper or plastic bag before disposal</li> </ul>
<b>Cat poo (all pet poo)</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Dispose in your garbage bin (red lid) or take to a <a href="#">Moorabool Shire Transfer Station</a> (fees apply)</li> <li>• Wrap in old newspaper or plastic bag</li> <li>• Recycle by using a Green Cone Solar Composter or EnsoPet Poo Composter</li> </ul>
<b>CDs</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Reuse by donating to your local charity/op-shop</li> <li>• Reuse by stringing up in your garden to deter pests or for craft projects</li> <li>• Dispose in your garbage bin (red lid) or take to a <a href="#">Moorabool Shire Transfer Station</a> (fees apply)</li> </ul>
<b>CD cases (plastic)</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Dispose in your garbage bin (red lid) or take to a <a href="#">Moorabool Shire Transfer Station</a> (fees apply)</li> </ul>
<b>CD players</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Reuse by selling, swapping, or giving away. Try eBay, Gumtree or local Buy Swap Sell pages.</li> <li>• Contact your local Op Shop – find out if they accept working electronic items</li> <li>• Recycle as e-waste at a <a href="#">Moorabool Shire Transfer Station</a> (no cost)</li> <li>• Never put any electronic item in a household bin, e-waste is banned from landfill and is a contaminant in the recycling bin.</li> </ul>
<b>Cellophane</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Recycle at Coles Bacchus Marsh via the <a href="#">REDcycle soft plastics recycling program</a></li> <li>• Dispose in your garbage bin (red lid) or take to a <a href="#">Moorabool Shire Transfer Station</a> (fees apply)</li> </ul>
<b>Ceramics</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Dispose in your garbage bin (red lid) or take to a <a href="#">Moorabool Shire Transfer Station</a> (fees apply)</li> <li>• Reuse by giving away or donating to your local charity/op-shop</li> <li>• Broken ceramics can be used for creative art projects</li> </ul>
<b>Cereal boxes</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Recycle in your recycling bin (yellow lid) or take to a <a href="#">Moorabool Shire Transfer Station</a></li> </ul>
<b>Cereal box inner plastic bags</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Dispose in your garbage bin (red lid) or take to a <a href="#">Moorabool Shire Transfer Station</a> (fees apply)</li> <li>• Recycle at Coles Bacchus Marsh via the <a href="#">REDcycle soft plastics recycling program</a></li> </ul>
<b>Chemicals (household)</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Recycle through <a href="#">Detox Your Home</a></li> </ul>
<b>Chemicals (Farm Chemicals and DrumMUSTER)</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Dispose of unwanted agricultural or non-household chemicals through <a href="#">ChemClear</a>.</li> </ul>

<b>Chip packets (foil-lined plastic)</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Dispose in your garbage bin (red lid) or take to a <a href="#">Moorabool Shire Transfer Station</a> (fees apply)</li> <li>• Recycle at Coles Bacchus Marsh via the <a href="#">REDcycle soft plastics recycling program</a></li> </ul>
<b>Chocolate wrappers (foil-lined plastic)</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Dispose in your garbage bin (red lid) or take to a <a href="#">Moorabool Shire Transfer Station</a> (fees apply)</li> <li>• Recycle at Coles Bacchus Marsh via the <a href="#">REDcycle soft plastics recycling program</a></li> </ul>
<b>Chux wipes</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Dispose in your garbage bin (red lid) or take to a <a href="#">Moorabool Shire Transfer Station</a> (fees apply)</li> <li>• Reuse until cannot be reused anymore – wash in washing machine to get more life out of them</li> <li>• Avoid by using reusable cloths instead</li> </ul>
<b>Cigarette butts</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Dispose in your garbage bin (red lid) or take to a <a href="#">Moorabool Shire Transfer Station</a> (fees apply)</li> <li>• Tip: When out and about, carry a container to collect butts until you find a bin. Cigarette butts persist in the natural environment for many years - never litter!</li> </ul>
<b>Cleaning rags</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Dispose in your garbage bin (red lid) or take to a <a href="#">Moorabool Shire Transfer Station</a> (fees apply)</li> <li>• Avoid by using reusable rags instead</li> </ul>
<b>Cling wrap/cling film/plastic wrap</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Dispose in your garbage bin (red lid) or take to a <a href="#">Moorabool Shire Transfer Station</a> (fees apply)</li> <li>• Some brands of cling wrap (Glad, Coles Home Brand and Woolworths Essentials) can be recycled at Coles Bacchus Marsh via the <a href="#">REDcycle soft plastics recycling program</a></li> <li>• Use reusable containers or bees wax wraps instead</li> </ul>
<b>Clothing (good condition)</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Reuse by having a clothes swap with friends or selling online, at a market, etc</li> <li>• Reuse quality items by donating to your local charity/op-shop or putting in a clothing/textile donation bin</li> <li>• Recycle by dropping off at select clothing retailers - see <a href="#">H&amp;M Group</a> and <a href="#">Zara</a></li> <li>• Recycle by sending to <a href="#">Upparel</a></li> <li>• Recycle by donating to <a href="#">Southern Cross Recycling</a></li> </ul>
<b>Clothing (damaged)</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Reuse as rags at home</li> <li>• Recycle by donating to <a href="#">Southern Cross Recycling</a></li> <li>• Recycle by sending to <a href="#">Upparel</a></li> <li>• Donate to local mechanics</li> <li>• Dispose in your garbage bin (red lid) or take to a <a href="#">Moorabool Shire Transfer Station</a> (fees apply)</li> </ul>
