## Western Renewables Link EES Information Guide

#### **Key Dates**

#### Public submissions open from Monday 30 June to Friday 22 August 2025

The EES will be exhibited for public comment for 40 business days, along with the draft Planning Scheme Amendment (draft PSA) for the project. Members of the public can make a submission during this time.

The full EES and draft PSA documents can be accessed online and in person:

- Western Renewables Link website.
- Public exhibition locations.
- Contact AusNet to be mailed a free summary report and USB stick of all digital files.

The Minister for Planning will appoint an independent inquiry and advisory committee to review public submissions and hold a public hearing from sometime during the week beginning 27 October 2025, for a period of approximately 7-9 weeks, depending on the number of submitters. It is intended that the hearing would be paused until mid-January 2026 if not all submitters can be heard prior to Christmas.

After the hearing, the committee will deliver a report to the Minister between January and April 2026 with conclusions and recommendations to inform the Minister's Assessment.
