Grey Box (<i>Eucalyptus microcarpa</i>) Grassy Woodlands and Derived Native Grasslands of South-eastern Australia	Endangered	Known Potential in area at western extent of AOI (Lexton to Bulgana region) and known to occur in the vicinity of Bacchus Marsh.	High Clearing of woodland areas and grassy former woodlands areas that satisfy policy condition thresholds for protection.
Natural Temperate Grassland of the Victorian Volcanic Plain	Critically Endangered	Known in east, moderate elsewhere within the Victorian Volcanic Plain Bioregion only.	High Clearing of grassland areas within the Victorian Volcanic Plain that satisfy policy condition thresholds for protection.
Seasonal Herbaceous Wetlands (Freshwater) of the Temperate Lowland Plains	Critically Endangered	High May occur in areas mapped as wetlands throughout the AOI.	Moderate Disturbance to wetlands, if any.
White Box-Yellow Box-Blakely's Red Gum Grassy Woodland and Derived Native Grassland	Critically Endangered	Moderate Constituent species occur between Lexton and the western end of the AOI near Bulgana, though this TEC is largely restricted to areas north of the Great Dividing Range.	High Clearing of woodland areas and grassy former woodlands areas that satisfy policy condition thresholds for protection.
