INFRASTRUCTURE UPDATE

Road and Infrastructure Works

Gravel sheeting works commenced on the 18th of January on Bridge Rd, Sand Rd and Hopgoods Rd. Routine maintenance, pothole works and minor pavement repairs will be undertaken on Rosenows Rd and Smith Lane as priority.

Forestry

Pine plantation harvesting is scheduled to commence off Bridge Rd and off Sand Rd over the next two weeks. Haul routes for harvested timber include Sand Rd, Bridge Rd and Horsehill West Rd. Gravel sheeting works are being co-ordinated with the Plantation Operators.

ATO ADVICE FOR BUSINESS OPERATORS AFFECTED BY THE SCOTSBURN FIRE

If you've been impacted by the recent bushfires, you don't need to worry about your tax affairs right away.

The ATO understands that you may need time to deal with more immediate concerns and can help you sort out your tax affairs later, including giving you more time to lodge or pay.

If you have records that have been damaged, the ATO may also be able to help you construct your tax records.

VISIT BY MINISTER JAALA PULFORD

The Minister for Agriculture and Regional Development visited the recovery Centre on Monday 18 Jan to announce funding to assist with the clean-up, recovery efforts and community events.

Assistance provided for demolition and clean-up of properties in Wye River and Separation Creek has been extended to include fire affected properties in Scotsburn.

Clean up costs for properties and roads will be shared between insurers and by the Commonwealth and Victorian Governments under the Natural Disaster Relief and Recovery Arrangements (NDRRA).

The assistance announced is in addition to support already being provided under NDRRA, announced on 21 December.


